# Competitor feedback report for RS400 European and UK Nationals 2018




### Background

- This survey was conducted amongst crew and helms who participated in the Weymouth RS400 European and UK nationals in August 2018
- The fieldwork took place in early December 2018 with circa 100 participants invited by email to take part in a short surveymonkey online survey.
- 52 replies were received which means the response rate was x%
- A key objective for the research was to find out what kind of starts competitors preferred as well as to gauge reaction to the event as a whole.


### In which fleet did you finish your racing in the regatta?




### How would you rate the regatta overall?




### How would you rate the regatta overall?




#### Please tell us what kind of start/fleet organisation you'd like at future major events?




Please tell us what kind of start/fleet organisation you'd like at future major events? Between 60 -79 boats entered




How would you rate the race organisation at the RS400 European and UK Nationals in 2018?




### How would you rate the race organisation at the RS400 European and UK Nationals in 2018?



# How would you rate the venue facilities (Weymouth &Portland National Sailing Academy)?




How would you rate the off the water events programme at the European and UK Nationals in 2018?



# How likely is it that you would recommend an RS400 European and/or UK Nationals event to a friend or colleague?








