GENERAL INFORMATION

ARRIVAL

Dinghy parking will be on the Elcho Green which, if approaching the town from the West (Edinburgh side), is on Beach Road on your left, after you come down Station Hill.

The Elcho Green will be open for dinghy parking on Sunday 7th August. The diagram below shows the entrance to the dinghy park and we ask that you park your dinghy towards the eastern end of the green with the bow facing towards the sea. Please unhitch your dinghy as quickly as possible and then park your car away from the Elcho Green. This is to make sure that we can keep traffic flowing freely if a number of boats happen to arrive at the same time.

Please do not attempt to bring your dinghy down to the harbour area as you will be faced with a tricky journey through or around the town to get to the Elcho Green dinghy park.



PARKING

Unfortunately no car parking is available at the Clubhouse, nor on the Elcho Green, which is reserved strictly for dinghy parking only. However, there are a number of public car parks in the town centre which are a short walk away from the Clubhouse.

REGISTRATION

- All competitors are required to register upon arrival. Registration will in the Sail Loft at the club house – between 2 and 5pm on Sunday and 9 and 10am on Monday.
- Trolley tags will be handed out which must be attached to the bow of your launch trolley.
- Dinghies will be berthed in buddy groups. Berthing plan will be available on a nearby notice board and the berth number will be marked on the floor

CLUB ACCESS

- Changing Rooms and toilets will be open from 09:00 until 23.00
- Space is limited in the changing rooms. If possible, please change for racing before you arrive at the Club or by your boat.

CATERING

- Breakfast will be available every day from 9-11am (from 8am on Friday). We will have a range of bacon/sausage rolls, hot drinks & snacks.
- Evening meals will be served as per the timetable above
- Please book meals in advance; there will be a limited number of tickets available to purchase at the registration, but it will really help us if you can order before you leave home.

BAR & LICENSING

North Berwick local bylaws prohibit drinking alcohol in publics spaces.

Please support the club and their volunteers by only drinking alcohol purchased from the club bar on club premises.
