## **Allergens**

We have been advised that several sailors in the fleet have a **nut allergy**, one of which is severe. ### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

#### **ARRIVAL**

The club address is Mounts Bay Sailing Club, Godolphin Steps, Marazion, TR17 0EN.

The Dinghy pen will be open for dinghy parking from Friday 28<sup>th</sup> July, see above timetable for drop-off times.

### **REGISTRATION**

- All competitors are required to register. Registration will in the clubhouse between 15.00 and 18.00 on Sunday 30<sup>th</sup> July and 09.00 and 10.30am on Monday 31<sup>st</sup> July.
- Trolley tags will be handed out which must be attached to the bow of your launch trolley.
- Dinghies will be berthed in buddy groups. Berthing plan will be available on a nearby notice board and the berth number will be marked on the floor.

#### **CLUB ACCESS**

- Changing Rooms and toilets will be open from 09:00 until 23.00.
- Space is limited in the changing rooms. If possible, please change for racing before you arrive at the Club or beside your boat.

#### **CATERING**

- Breakfast will be available from Sunday 30<sup>th</sup> to Friday 4<sup>th</sup> August from 9-11am. We will have a range of bacon/sausage rolls, hot drinks & snacks.
- Evening meals will be served as per the timetable above.
- Please book meals in advance; there may be a limited number of tickets available to purchase at the registration, but it will really help us if you can order before you leave home.

### **DEPARTURE**

- The dinghy park must be cleared by 18:00 on Saturday 5<sup>th</sup> August. Please arrange with MBSC Beachmaster if your boat needs to be stored in MBSC pen until Sunday.
